Special Session 9

Background and objective

UNDP and UN-Habitat, in collaboration with Oliver Wyman, have developed a policy framework to guide Arab countries emerging from conflict or crisis and entering a process of infrastructure reconstruction. While cities are the *dominant organizing principle of human coexistence* and undoubtedly generate a variety of synergies and benefits, they can also become sites of magnified vulnerability in the case of conflict or crisis, especially if infrastructure is destroyed and residents are left without access to basic services. A sustainable reconstruction process builds on a robust, inclusive and holistic assessment of the current situation and needs, ensuring that conflict over scarce resources does not exacerbate simmering tensions and lead to protracted instability. It requires interventions targeting all sections of the Humanitarian-Development-Peace nexus from the outset, ensuring a smooth transition from recovery to reconstruction and eventually to risk reduction.

This technical session will present the elements of the policy framework and discuss reconstruction experiences from across the Arab region. The aim is to generate dialogue and receive inputs and feedback from partners and relevant experts working on sustainable reconstruction in post-conflict contexts.

- What constitutes sustainable reconstruction and is it possible to consider at a time of crisis?
- What is the economic and socio-environmental case for sustainable reconstruction in urban spaces in post conflict settings?
- Are there examples of sustainable reconstruction in the Arab region?
